**TWO-PART REGISTRATION PROCESS OPENS Wednesday, January 15, 2020**

Rotary clubs register and pay online for the number of candidates they intend to send to program. There are no refunds, so it is suggested that you may want to select an alternate participant.

**SLAPSHOT – Student Leadership Award Program for Students High On Training**, is dedicated to promoting, honoring, celebrating and nurturing young leaders, who are high school students, 15-18 years old.

**SLAPSHOT** takes place over a full weekend, May 1-3, 2020, on the beautiful campus of The Adventure Learning Centre at Canterbury Hills in Ancaster, Ontario, Canada. The primary focus is to maximize the promotion of leadership, self-esteem and teamwork. Six meals and two overnight stays in cabin settings provide the backdrop for training in listening and interpersonal skills, assertiveness and problem-solving, team building and presentation skills. Each year, students leave **SLAPSHOT** feeling more confident in themselves and prepared to strengthen their involvement with Interact Clubs and other initiatives that they believe will make a difference in their schools and local communities and beyond.

**SLAPSHOT** offers the perfect opportunity for 100 high school students throughout District 7090 to come together for a wonderful experience in fun, fellowship and learning. The program is founded on Rotary ideals and serves as a strong link on the continuum of Rotary's youth leadership development opportunities – Youth Exchange, RYLA, EarlyAct, Interact and Rotaract.

**SLAPSHOT 2020 TWO-PART REGISTRATION PROCESS**

**1<sup>st</sup> go online to [www.rotary7090](http://www.rotary7090) and register the number of candidates you want to send and pay by credit card - payment (\$350 CAD per student), then select your student participants per: **SLAPSHOT Selection Guidelines** below.**

- Review **SLAPSHOT 2020 STUDENT PARTICIPANT INFORMATION & APPLICATION PACKAGE** with each student selected.
- Secure from each student **THREE completed APPLICATION FORMS** as follows:
  1. **ROTARY DISTRICT 7090 SLAPSHOT 2020 APPLICATION**
  2. **Adventureworks Health and Safety Form**
  3. **Adventureworks Assumption of Risk and Responsibility Form**

*If the applicant is under age 18, all 3 forms must be signed by his/her parent or guardian.*
- Complete **CLUB REGISTRATION FORM #2** on page 4 of this package.

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE...**

**All REGISTRATION FEES & completed CLUB & STUDENT PARTICIPANT FORMS must be received by the SLAPSHOT REGISTRAR no later than March 31, 2020.**

### **GUIDELINES FOR SELECTING SLAPSHOT PARTICIPANT(S)**

Clubs are encouraged to seek applications from young leaders, 15-18 years, who are known to members of their club or Rotary contacts in their local high schools. Applicants must be current high school students. **Students who have previously attended SLAPSHOT are NOT ELIGIBLE. This is a 'once in a lifetime' award.**

Applicants first present their applications to contact(s) in their high school and/or local Rotary club, who then make a selection. The club then forwards one copy of the three completed participant applications for each of the students selected to the SLAPSHOT Registrar.

When selecting your participants, look for maturity, enthusiasm and interest in making a positive difference in their school and community. In order to achieve maximum benefit from SLAPSHOT, it's important that candidates demonstrate their ability to communicate effectively and work well together with other students and their teachers.

Be sure that applicants understand that they must commit to full participation for the duration of the weekend program. Candidates must be free from work or other commitments during the entire weekend, 24 hours a day.

Before forwarding to the SLAPSHOT Registrar the required information for each student selected, review all **THREE Participant Application Forms** to check that they are complete and include accurate contact information, necessary signatures, and who to notify in case of emergency/accident etc.

### **RESPONSIBILITY OF PARTICIPATING ROTARY CLUBS**

- Select and sponsor SLAPSHOT participant(s) – *maximum FIVE students*
- **Submit payment in the amount of \$350 CAD per student by online registration.**

***PAID REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE! In case of last minute cancellation(s), it is important that your club selects at least ONE or more alternate student participant(s).***

- Submit **3 FORMS**, completed by EACH STUDENT PARTICIPANT re: *STUDENT PARTICIPANT INFORMATION & APPLICATION PACKAGE* to the SLAPSHOT Registrar **NO LATER THAN MARCH 31, 2020** with completed **CLUB REGISTRATION FORM #2** (p.4 of this package)
- Ensure that all documents, as distributed by the Registrar in advance of the SLAPSHOT 2020 weekend, are made available to registered students
- Provide transportation for participant(s) to and from The Adventure Learning Centre at Canterbury Hills, Ancaster, Ontario, CANADA. [www.adventureworks.org](http://www.adventureworks.org)
- Arrange, as appropriate, for SLAPSHOT 2020 participant(s) to attend a Rotary club meeting to speak about his/her/their experience & obtain, to the extent possible, local media coverage for the participant(s) and SLAPSHOT program
