List of NOT ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- All Non-Electronic Waste: Items that do not have <u>BOTH</u> a circuit board and a power cord.
- Techno-Trash including CD's/DVD's, VHS, Beta, Cassettes, DAT Tapes, Memory Sticks and Floppy Discs.
- All Batteries: All batteries must be removed from consumer electronic devices (CEAR will manage and recycle the batteries with a fee. SRCC will deduct battery recycling fee from funds earned).
- All Lamps and Fluorescent Light Bulbs, incandescent Light Bulbs, and Christmas Tree Lights. (CEAR will manage and recycle the batteries with a fee. SRCC will deduct battery recycling fee from funds earned).
- Hazardous Household Waste: Paint, Pesticides, Used Oil, Cleaning Supplies, Propane Tanks, Fire Extinguishers, or Tires.
- Contaminated Electronic Waste such as medical equipment that has not been decontaminated.
- Large Household Appliances: Refrigerators, Washers, and Dryers. Stoves, Ovens, Water Heaters, Air Conditioners, etc.
- Household Items: Furniture, Cordless Power Tools, Toys, Smoke Detectors.
- All Mercury Containing Devices: Electric Irons, Thermostats, and Switches.
- All Wood, including wood-encased Stereo Speakers.
- Pressurized Containers: Fire Extinguishers and Propane Canisters.

- Radioactive Devices.
- Furniture.
- Vacuum Cleaners.
