Public Image Strategies to Help Raise your Club's Visibility - DG Laine Hendricks (Room 158 - Breakout II Only)

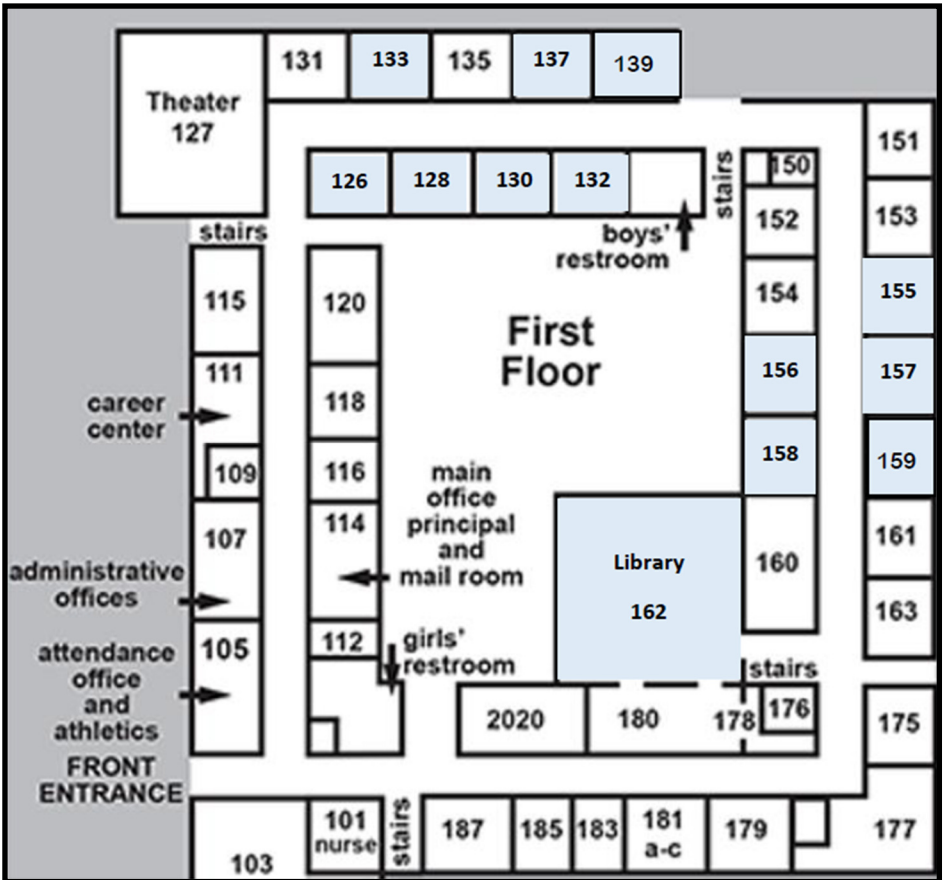
Enjoy a discussion about public image strategies you can employ to help your club raise its visibility in your community while empowering your members to be Rotary Ambassadors.
